The purpose of the 12-member North Park Project Area Committee (PAC) is to advise and consult with the City of San Diego Redevelopment Agency regarding redevelopment activity within the North Park Project Area. The PAC serves as a communication link between the Agency and Project Area property owners, residents, business owners and community organizations. It keeps the community informed and communicates its concerns and suggestions to the Agency. The North Park PAC meets on the second Tuesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. on the second floor of the San Diego National Bank Building.

### Residential Tenant Seat

On Tuesday, July 8, 2008, the North Park Redevelopment Project Area Committee (PAC) will vote to appoint a new member to fill a recently vacated Residential Tenant seat. The meeting will be held on the second floor of the San Diego National Bank Building located at 3180 University Ave. from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Community members within the Project Area are encouraged to apply as candidates.

The person appointed to fill the recently vacated Residential Tenant seat will serve on the PAC for the seven (7) months remaining in the term of this seat. The seat will be subject to election again in February of 2009.

Potential candidates must submit a Candidate Registration Form, provide proof of eligibility for the applicable PAC category and comply with the requirements of the North Park Redevelopment Project Area Committee (PAC), Conflict of Interest Code and the Political Reform Act.
