

JULY 2007 BALLOT - VOTING ANALYSIS

The following is a preliminary analysis of the voting for the new Maintenance Assessment District which was defeated by a narrow margin in July. This data is still being analyzed and is subject to change. Single family and condo owners were overwhelmingly in favor of the new MAD. However, apartment owners (who represented 37.46% of the vote compared to 31.71% for the single family/condo folks) voted heavily against it. The commercial property owners also voted against the new MAD but by a much smaller percentage. This information is being studied by the Committee. Watch here for updates.
